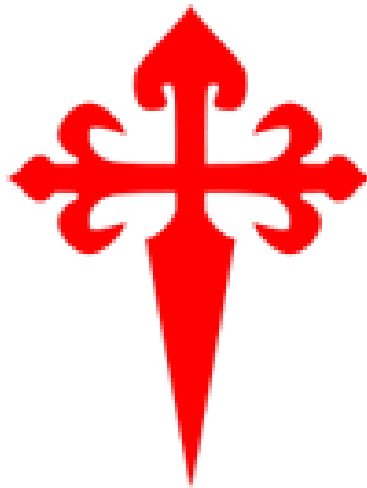

## Albergues on the Camino Francés

'There are around 500 albergues along the camino. And the number is increasing every year. In this summary a selection has been made of favorite albergues, based on the reviews from previous year's pilgrims as well as on my own experience.

There are four different types of albergues:

**Municipal albergues** are sponsored by local government bodies and often staffed by volunteers. In general they belong to the most inexpensive albergues. They can be rather basic.

**Parochial albergues** are operated by religious institutions such as monasteries, convents or local churches. They tend to be simple, but may offer a lot of care by volunteer caretakers. Many of these accommodations are on a donation basis (*donativo*) or for a low fixed price.

**Association albergues** are operated by various pilgrim associations from around the world. They are often staffed by volunteers who have done the Camino before. Association albergues are supplemented by donations, so are often offered on a donation basis or a low fee.

**Private albergues** are owned and run by private individuals. Private albergues often offer more comfortable accommodations with "extra" amenities such as meals, wash/dryer, internet, wifi, etc. Some private albergues are owned by former pilgrims and have a cozy feel, others have more of an impersonal hotel feel.
